GRAPHICS POSTER COMPETITION

This is a graphics poster competition. The images or graphics used in the poster should be generated by computer software. The poster will be judged on the quality of the graphics, sophistication of the design, and the story, process and/or the design idea conveyed in the poster.

The general topics used for the papers of the conference

(https://www.asee.org/uploads_public/conferences/session_owner/call_for_papers_file/0000/1248/2017_asee_edgd_call_for_papers.pdf) may be used to provide topics for the poster graphics but adherence to such is not a necessity.

The following should guide the layout of the poster:

- Title - Bold large text
- Abstract - 150 - 200 words
- Introduction - No more than 200 hundred words,
the main feature of the poster should be the graphics
- Figures - Figures should be labelled
- Legend - Only if the needs justify such
- Size - 36" x 48" (91cm x 121cm)

Submission

Submission of the electronic draft of the poster should be made by September 26, 2017.

The poster should be submitted as a PDF file. All the essential elements for approval consideration should be included on the draft poster. However colour scheme and additional rendering of drawing can be done subsequent to electronic submission.

Competition

Applicants are required to make a 10-minute presentation on January 4, 2018 at the ASEE conference in Montego Bay, Jamaica. This 10-minute period will include the time for the Presentation and the Question-and-Answer session.

The students will be required to mount their posters on supplies provided by the organising committee. At the specified time, the students will present their work within 5 minutes and there will be 5 minutes designated for answering questions from the judges.

All the posters that are short-listed will be placed in the conference proceeding, with the top three posters (selected by the judges) published in the ASEE Journal

The cash prizes for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in the competition are \$250, \$150 and \$100 (US dollars) respectively.

Rules to Enter

- Any student or group of students that were registered in an recognised tertiary institution up to April 2017 may apply
- Posters must consist of original work prepared by the students and not used for any previous poster competition
- Application should be submitted with the electronic draft poster on September 26, 2017
- The poster images should all be generated electronically with computer software
- There should be good organisation/sequences of figures on poster to convey the story, process or sequencing, and/or design idea.
- The deadline for submission of the hard copy version of the poster is November 14, 2017.
