Hear the fascinating story Ralph O’Neill, who was inducted into the Arizona Aviation Hall of Fame in 2012. He flew 103 combat missions with the 147<sup>th</sup> Aero Squadron (a squadron mate of Ernest Love of Prescott); started a functional Mexican Air Force in the 1920s and the New York Rio & Buenos Aires Airline in 1929, which later merged with Pan Am. Alan has written extensively about him and also made a wonderful presentation about our own Ernest Love in 2008.
