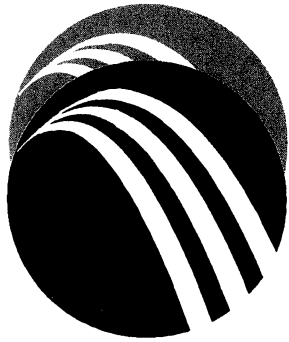

EDITORIAL PROCEDURE

The *Journal of Aviation/Aerospace Education and Research (JAAER)* is interested in publishing scholarly articles about aviation/aerospace history, educators, curriculum development, innovative methods of instruction, significant research findings that relate to aviation/aerospace education, and industry and education partnerships, as well as the most current academic thought concerning current issues of interest to **JAAER** readers. Although the *Journal* has a collegiate focus, manuscripts concerning secondary and elementary education are also encouraged.

JAAER is a refereed publication although a limited number of non-refereed submissions may be included in each issue. Manuscripts will be blind-reviewed by members of the editorial staff, a process which will take a minimum of 60 days. If authors have any questions concerning the status of their manuscript, they are encouraged to contact the *Journal* office.

Authors should submit five copies of their manuscript to the editor. The most current edition of the *Publications Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA)* should be used as a style guide for manuscripts. However, authors are instructed to include all tables and figures in the body of the manuscript. Normally, papers will not be returned; if specifically requested, one copy of the manuscript will be returned.

Manuscripts should be typed, entirely double spaced, with wide margins on all sides. The title of the manuscript should be clearly indicative of its subject and of the author's intention; the title should not be unnecessarily long or convoluted. Authors should include an abstract and a short biographical sketch with their initial submission. Refer to this or previous issues of **JAAER** for acceptable documentation models.
