Leadership is an <u>influence</u> relationship among leaders and followers who intend real changes that reflect their mutual purposes.

(Rost, 1991, p. 102)

Leadership is the process whereby an individual <u>influences</u> a group of individuals to achieve a common goal.

(Northouse, 2007, p. 3)


"Leadership is the process of <u>influencing</u> others to understand and agree about what needs to be done and how to do it."







