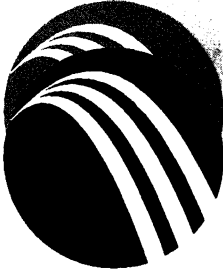

If you are interested in contributing a manuscript for possible publication, please use our author's guidelines, below.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONTRIBUTORS

Submission of Papers Manuscript copies should be on standard bond paper (copy machine, typing, or computer paper) that will take ink corrections.

Preparation of Manuscripts Authors should submit five copies of their manuscript. The most current edition of the *Publications Manual of the American Psychological Association* (APA) is used as a style guide for manuscripts. However, authors are instructed to include all tables in the body of the manuscript. Manuscripts should be typed on white paper, entirely double spaced, with wide margins (1.5"-2") on both sides, top, and bottom, and conform to APA style guidelines. **Do not right (full) justify the manuscript.**

Title The title of the manuscript should be clearly indicative of its subject and of the author's intention, and should not be unnecessarily long or convoluted.

Documentation Manuscripts should conform to APA reference documentation.

EDITORIAL FOCUS

The Journal of Aviation/Aerospace Education & Research (JAAER) is a scholarly publication for educators and researchers as well as for professionals in the aviation and aerospace industry. The focus on how the educational process is influenced by various segments of the aviation and aerospace community, and on how education affects the industry, is not confined to colleges and universities but is meant to embrace elementary and secondary education, as well.

The *Journal* is interested in scholarly submissions about aviation/aerospace history, educators, curriculum development, innovative methods of instruction, significant research findings that relate to aviation/aerospace education, and industry and education partnerships. We also wish to reflect the latest industry and academic thought concerning current issues of interest to **JAAER** readers.

The **JAAER** is a refereed publication. Manuscripts will be blind-reviewed by members of the editorial staff as well as a limited number of professionals in that field. This review process will take a minimum of 60 days. From time to time, a limited number of non-refereed articles may be included in a **FORUM** section.
