Administration to shut down Residence Hall I

By the time I returned from one weekend trip I had accumulated eight calls from the other Mr. Cambron. I just hope he does not owe any Italians a lot of money.

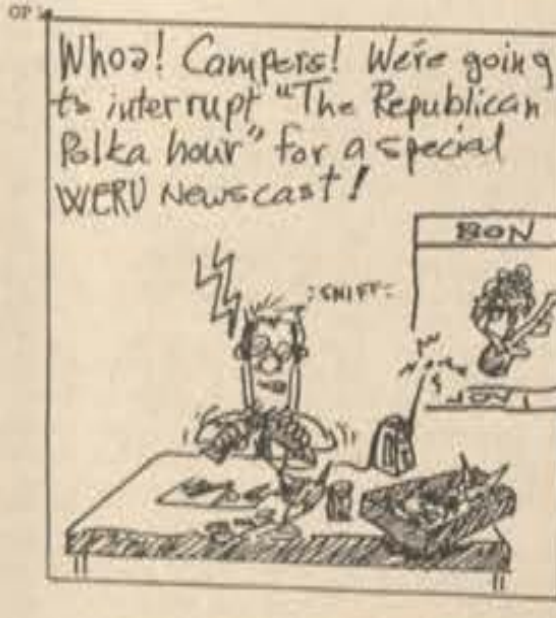

Campus Security makes a 'lucrative purchase'

In an announcement that stunned the local community and the nation, the Old MacDonald Security Department, or the Hee-Haw 5-0, purchased a robotic crime prevention machine to quell the recent ludicrous rise in crime on campus and at ABC II (All-the-way-out-on Beville Complex II).

Paranoid Manics, the director of security for Old MacDonald, commented that the robot is expected to end campus crime by the end of the Spring term. Study claims Japanese were correct

But group's results may be skewed by ex-Commie sympathizer, member says

NEW YORK (IP)— In a press conference, Al B. Spitonne, spokesman for the Committee to Enrage American Society, claimed that a two-month-long study into the work level of Americans at the work place proved that the average American is not "motivated to work a full day for a full day's pay."

However, Mr. Spitonne himself has been involved in controversial claims made by a member of CEAS, overshadowing the study's claims.

The report included the gaging of responses "by American and Japanese workers in interviews. The interviewees came from such fields as automobile manufacturing, international trade, grocery store service, stock market trading, ticket scalping, and prostitution. Both countries were represented equally in every field.

The Japanese, the study claims, worked more hours, drank more regular coffee, took more anti-acid pills, considered and committed suicide more often, made it to work on time more often, and punched each other inside government buildings more often, and are more willing to be 'on top.'

"These results clearly indicate that the Japanese are much more

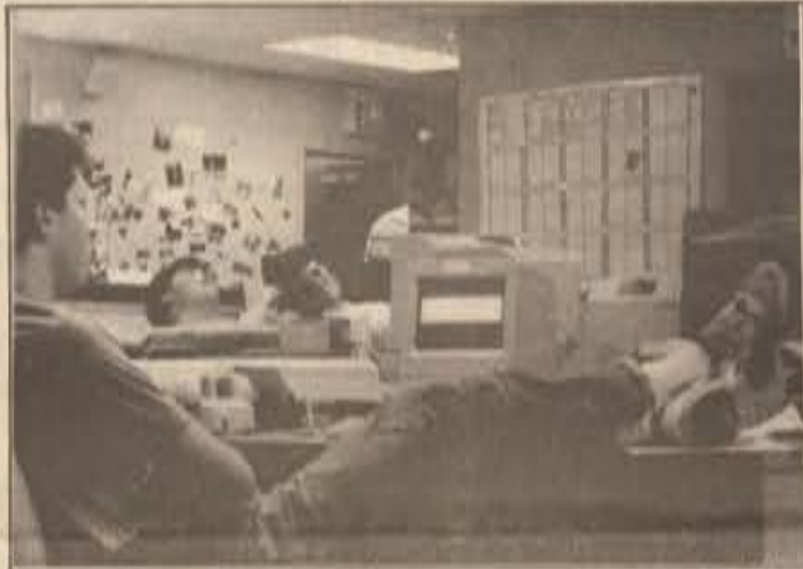
motivated," the spokesman said.

The comments Monday led many in government and politics to refute the study's claims. Duke Blazfeom (R-LA) said that Americans "are not on average a lazy people. There's only certain groups among us, that I won't name, that are lazy. But I see no reason for those squinted tube steaks to say anything about us. I'm not a bigot, but haven't they learned to leave us alone after Hiroshima?"

"Ridiculous," said Sen. Ralph Knightly (D-MA), when asked for his thoughts on the study's findings. "If Americans are lazy, then why do I see so many women with incredible bodies passing my beach front home in Florida? Those babes couldn't be lazy," he joked. Knightly added that we "should not worry about the uptight little Japanese and their noise."

"The Prime Minister said he didn't mean it, and we should believe the little guy," the senator said. "Next time I'm in Japan, the yellow little guy and I will have some saki and talk about what prompted him to say those things. We'll see if the girls there really like to be on top, too!"

Americans other than politicians are upset as well. Some of them suggest a different view, however. Chuck Compost, a sanitation engineer in Belcher, MA, said, "Why all

this anger? If the Japanese feel we are lazy, it's simply due to the differences in our societies and customs. The Japanese work longer hours, and are rarely out of the office before 6:00, maybe 7:00 p.m. They are strongly driven to work hard, and highly stressed, frankly.

"I see no reason to take such offense at their claim. If we aren't what they call us, why are we so touchy? I know I work hard, so I don't take it seriously. If we're lazy, perhaps the Japanese are too driven. Just look at their suicide level."

Others in America think that the U.S. reaction is out of fear that it is true, as Spitonne's group claims in their 44-page report on the study.

"If the report said blacks are lazy, or the lower class is lazy, or recently arrived immigrants are lazy, the majority of Americans wouldn't mouth off like they are now," Spitonne said. "We're a bunch of disgusting bigots, that's what we are!" he added.

CEAS sent a number of copies to the Japanese Parliament. Spitonne said he wishes he could be there to

watch their reactions to the report. He claims it will "bring the house down."

"I wish I could say this report wasn't inspired by the comments of the Japanese," Spitonne said, "but it would be a lie. We at CEAS wanted to find out for ourselves if Americans are lazy on the average. And, boy, are they!"

Those known in popular culture in America reacted in concert with Mr. Compost's comments concerning the Japanese standpoint. Rock star Bon TonJovi said of the Japanese in a recent interview with Slut magazine, "Hey, they dig our music, wear our clothes, try to dance like us, yet they say we're lazy. Well, maybe they don't know how to really let loose and enjoy this world we're in. Maybe they imitate us because we have so much fun. I mean, when was the last time you saw Newt Gingrich hit Sam Nunn or something like that?"

"They need to let loose, that's all," TonJovi said. "We can't blame 'em for thinking we're lazy. They're a bunch of little tight-asses."

CEAS's founder, Phil Mygutt, does not have a job besides being president of the organization, which has led those opposed to his organization to bash him with claims that he is lazy.

Mygutt's staff all have day jobs, but volunteer to work for his organi-

zation, doing everything from interviewing the Japanese to cutting his toenails, reportedly. "They're like my family," Mygutt said. "No other groups let them be involved, so I took them in. They are losers with a purpose. I admire that."

In an interview, an anonymous CEAS member said Spitonne talked of skewing the statistics because "he is a Communist sympathizer with no one to sympathize for now." The source said Spitonne is planning to "become a Buddhist and learn how to grow those neat little trees that the Japanese do. He likes the Japs, simply."

The person preferring to not give her name added that Spitonne has a severe inferiority complex and hates hot dogs, apple pie, and Chevrolets ever since he saw a U.S. senator kissing and fondling his sister in their family home's living room in 1969.

"He loves to hate America, but he loves the freedom in it which allows him to be himself—a paranoid, overly self-conscious, self-destructive, unpatriotic, repressed adult child of alcoholic parents," the unidentified woman commented.

The claims from the unspecified individual haven't been verified, and Spitonne could not be reached in his upper Oregon state block-style house in the forest for a comment.

Bing Crosby spotted golfing in Daytona

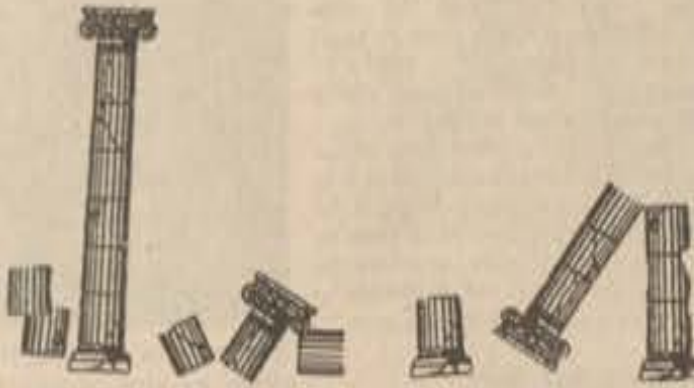

The Avioff will be closely following this story but until then, pray for cold weather and look for that quarter.



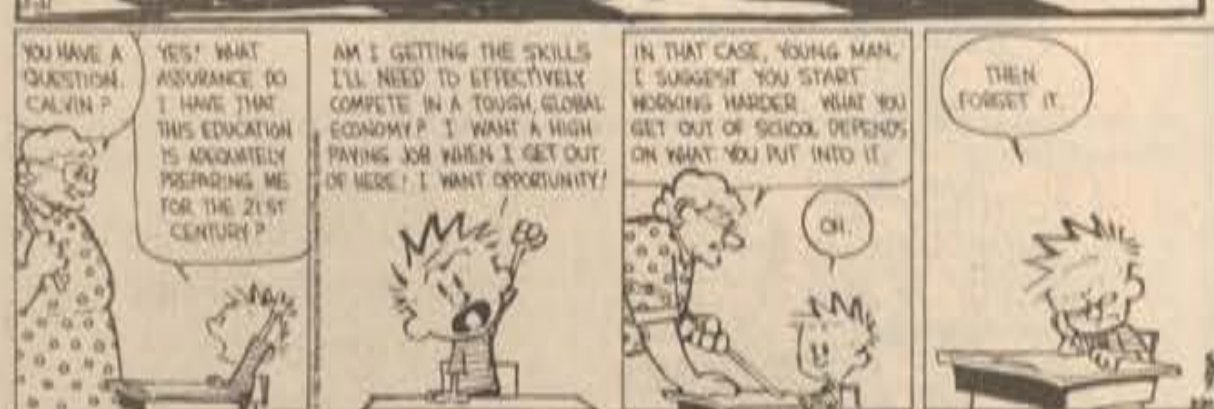

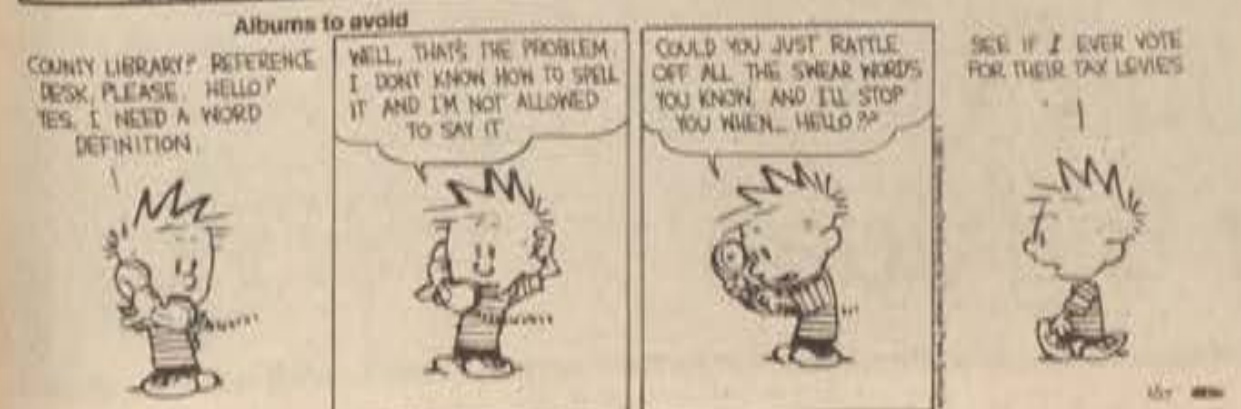

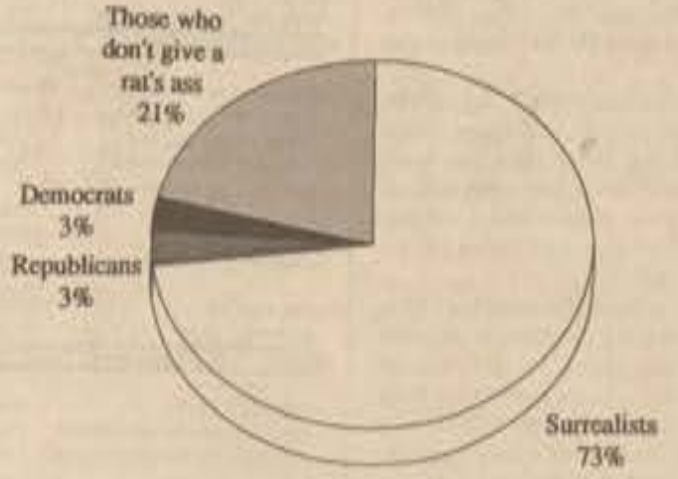
During a poll conducted by the Avioff, the people clearly thought they would be good for the country.

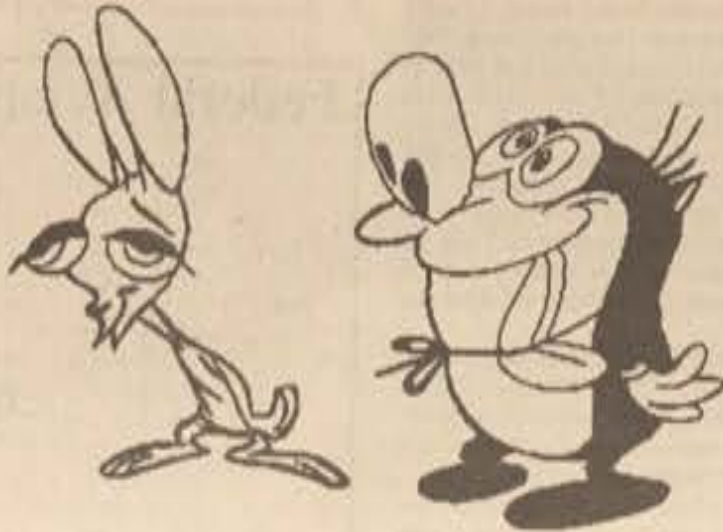
Paul Songass has endorsed the two and said he will help the two win the presidency. He stated that the country "needs them."

Man has been on the moon for a long time

A top secret classified Department of Defense internal report, obtain exclusively by the Avioff, confirms reports that man has already returned to the moon. The report states that the first crew returned to the moon on January 28, 1985, and has maintained a continually manned outpost since that time.

The 500 page report details mans return to the moon. The top secret program is coded named "*****". The concept of the "*****" program dates back to the days of the Apollo era. The spacecraft used for the program is a new generation nuclear powered craft which consists of a crew module and lunar module. The spacecraft is powered by two RTGs. A RTG is a Radioisotope Thermoelectric Generator, which provides electricity from the radioactive decay of plutonium-238 dioxide. The lunar module is similar in shape to the original Apollo lunar module but it is smaller in size due to the advances in composite materials and computer technology. Like the space shuttle orbiter, the entire lunar spacecraft is reusable.

The "*****" project began in 1981 when a Atlas rocket was launched from the Cape Canaveral Air Force Station. On board was the equipment needed to set up the lunar base. Once the equipment touched down on the lunar surface, robots were used to set up the underground lunar outpost. The first crew at the United States Defense Moon Outpost was a construction team which set up the lunar experiments, satellite communications and completed construction of the crew habitat and work areas. The first crew was launched aboard the Space Shuttle *Discovery*, the 15 shuttle flight. The first crew left the United States Defense Moon Outpost on October 1, 1985, when the Space Shuttle *Atlantis* was in orbit for a DoD mission.

The United States Defense Moon Outpost is located on the dark side of the moon, to prevent being spotted by observers on Earth. Once on the moon, the military crew is free to go about performing their scientific observations, above and below the lunar surface. Each crew traveling to the moon carries enough supplies for a one year stay. To date, seven, two man crews have been on the moon, with the eighth crew on the moon currently.

On a typical mission, the crew on the moon, departs from the lunar surface three days prior to the planned launch of the Department of Defense shuttle mission. If the space shuttle is delayed from its planned liftoff, the returning lunar module has enough fuel and supplies to remain in Earth orbit for 48 hours before it must return to the moon to resupply. When the two spacecrafts rendezvous in Earth orbit, the two lunar crews perform a complex series of events to end one mission and begin a second.

The new lunar crew is first set on its way with the help of the remote manipulator arm, while the returning crew orbits close to the space shuttle. After the new crew is on its way, the returning crew's spacecraft is placed in the cargo bay with the assistance of the remote arm and is returned to Earth with the space shuttle crew.

When one Kennedy Space Center employee was asked about these revelations, he commented, "This comes as a complete surprise to me, I thought they [Department of Defense] were putting up some spy satellite on the [former] Soviet Union."

The Embryo-Diddle Aerospace Colony is suspected to be highly involved in the program.

These are the only details that were not censored by military sources. The names of all crew members, specific dimensions of the lunar spacecraft, as well as other detailed informations is not available for reprint.
