ATF raids local YMCA

Semi-bearded wonder

For the past few weeks the residents of the apartment buildings adjacent to the YMCA on Derbyshire Road have complained about noises similar to gunshots. "These sounds have been reported as varying from a sudden single shot to a rapid succession of shots," said Miss Enfumayshun, the local Federal Public Relations officer at the pre-raid press conference.

In response, the Federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) executed a daring pre-dawn raid on the YMCA compound. Lt. Ian Michael Achiller lead the 3rd Armored Division, the Walla Walla Kazoo Band and an ATF Strike Team into the compound just seconds before 5:00 in the morning. 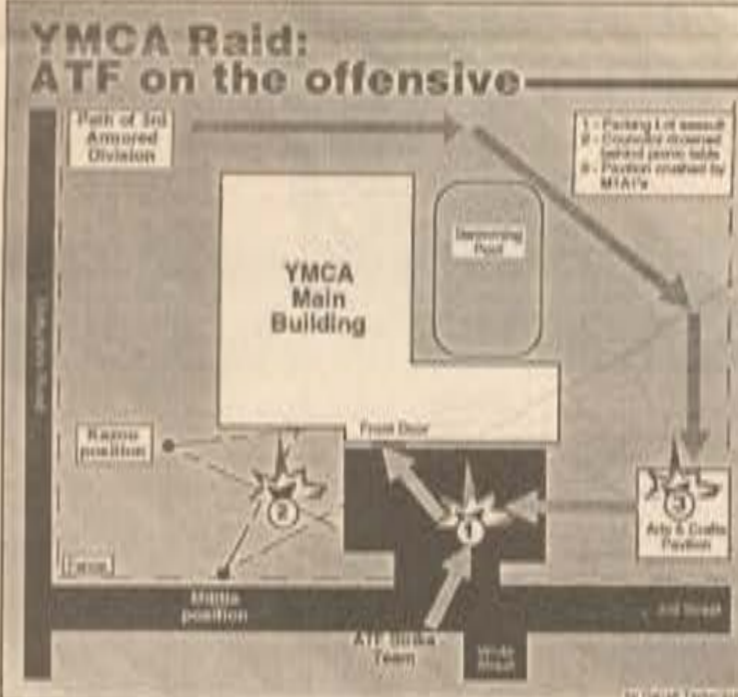
The frontal assault was led by an air strike from the Air National Guard's specially equipped 172 Chicken-hawks. The formation bombed the compound with three-week old student socks.

They quickly succumbed to the barrage by passing-out or surrendering. The cries of lamenting women and children from such an inhumane act rose above the din of mortal combat, only to be drowned out by the cries of the wounded.

"This was totally uncalled for, I'm not paid minimum wage to repel sieges," exclaimed Patty McDermott, a councilor that was taken to Halifax Medical Center. The attending paramedics reported that she had undergone an extremely vicious assault on her ego, and was not expected to regain self-confidence before the end of the month. In-between breaths, Comdr. Gunter Blauwspit shouted to the fast approaching media, "I am very hurt that Lt. Achiller did not see fit to invite us to the bust." After launching a goober laden projectile at one councilor hiding behind a picnic table, he continued, "My son was listening to the radio this morning and heard Achiller speak at the pre-raid press conference." Again, a bullet shaped piece of goobered paper flew towards the hapless councilor. This one hit with a sickening thud and a spray of spittle. The councilor hit the ground hard and continued to scream until he drowned on the shrapnel spittle.

After disappearing into the front office for several minutes, Lt. Achiller emerged with a large black gym bag. "I've got it, I've got it right here!" echoed in the now quiet compound. On hearing this, the remaining 3rd Armored, the Kazoo Band and the local Militia made a joint decision within seconds. This unprecedented communication and cooperation resulted in an unanimous decision that it was indeed "Miller time." All members of the offensive units retired for a cold one.

The ATF stayed behind, however, to clean up the puddles of spit left by both the Kazoons and the Militia. "This is a public safety hazard that we would not want any children to play in,"

said one ATF agent who wished not to be identified for security reasons. "Unfortunately, it is a by-product of the War on Drugs," he commented while squeezing out his mop on an unexploded tank shell.

At the post-raid debriefing Lt Achiller thanked the Militia for their support and presented the contents of the bag for the press and general viewing public. confidence for at least a week. Damage estimates were still being tabulated at the time of the debriefing, but are expected to top \$1.3 million in property damage to surrounding homes alone.

The casualties on the ATF Strike Team were "exceptionally light," said Miss Enfurmayshun. Fifty percent of the ATF Strike Team were either killed or listed as missing in action. "We are planning a second raid to recover our lost comrades later today," announced Achiller. Although he claims that the children that were dropped off by their parents after the raid will not present a problem to Operation Breakout, he has asked the Navy Reserve for an offshore bombardment of the area to "soften them up." Asked why such harsh measures were needed, he replied, "Have you ever been in a room with twenty-odd kids and NO supervisor? It's many people's definition of hell."

Last week, the United States Secret Service Agency raided a covert counterfeit operation in Spruance Castle, otherwise known as the Ivory Tower. Groundbreaking feeds homeless

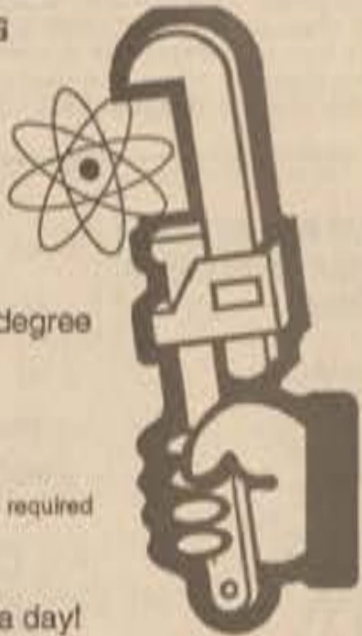

In this lab an experimental value of Young's Modulus was determined for steel, aluminum, and brass. A rod of the material was heated and the linear expansion was measured. This value was used to calculate Young's Modulus for the material. Results of the small sample size deviated from the accepted value, although the larger sample size of the entire class gave results closer to the accepted value.

This lab uses an experimental setup to determine values of Young's Modulus for three materials. Young's Modulus is the coefficient of expansion of a material, and relates the linear expansion of the material to its temperature. This coefficient was found by confining a rod of the material in a sheath so that it could only expand linearly, then heating the rod with steam and measuring the change in length. The apparatus used is shown below.

The equation used is based on a linear equation: $(MKS \text{ units})$. This equation is then solved for the coefficient of linear expansion: $(MKS \text{ units})$. The coefficient of linear expansion varies from metal to metal and will be

This experiment resulted in mean coefficient of linear expansion values relatively near to the expected values. The mean experimental value for brass was $1.935 \times 10^{-5} \text{ K}^{-1}$, only 3.25% below the Nobody will ever get this far anyway, value of $2.0 \times 10^{-5} \text{ K}^{-1}$. The mean experimental Young's Modulus obtained for steel was $1.27 \times 10^5 \text{ K}^{-1}$, 5.8% above the reference $1.2 \times 10^5 \text{ K}^{-1}$. The mean value calculated for aluminum was the farthest from the reference value of $2.4 \times 10^{-5} \text{ K}^{-1}$ with a value of $1.922 \times 10^{-5} \text{ K}^{-1}$, and a difference of 19.9%.

The results obtained by the class for steel and brass both verify the reference value within a few percentage points, amply covered by the 95% confidence interval. The result for aluminum was far enough from the reference value that more samples should be taken and averaged to fully agree with the reference value.

The difficulty in determining precisely when the vernier contacted the rod was the greatest source of error. Although the relative uncertainty of the vernier was only 0.03% due to the great number of delineations, the difficulty in blab blah, blah blither blabber the scale likely contributed to the uncertainty of the results to a noticeable extent. 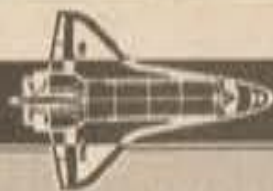

NASA closes LEGO deal

Brain Damage
He lives up to his name

In a press conference held at LEGO headquarters some time last week, NASA administrator Daniel Goldin announced the pending partnership between NASA and the toy making giant to construct an affordable space station.

Top NASA officials have scrapped the proposed U.S./Russian space station and settled on a design that uses many of the new LEGO parts currently on the drawing boards for their advanced space sets.

"Engineers at LEGO have demonstrated incredible attention to detail and realism in their new line of space sets, and we feel that this partnership will not only bring the cost of the space station down, but provide a really fun place to work as well."

Goldin said.

Goldin also cited the proliferous popularity of the plastic toy as a reason for the station design change. He did not deny that NASA was hoping to garner more support from the members of Congress who spent innumerable childhood hours laying on their stomachs in their living rooms searching through a pile of LEGO blocks for that one piece needed to finish their creation.

This will be LEGO's second government-funded venture, following on the heels of the failed Superconducting Super Legocollider, which couldn't quite overcome the major design constraint that plastic and liquid nitrogen just don't go together.

Because of the availability of LEGO parts, the station would be constructed in only five phases, almost four times as fast as the proposed U.S./Russian station. Goldin added

that the relative small size of the building blocks will help to bring the cost of the space station down even further. The shuttle cargo bay could carry literally millions of blocks into orbit at a time, giving the astronauts many hours of imaginative fun.

It was even mentioned that NASA should sponsor a design competition where children ages eight and up could enter their best space station design. The winner would be the Legomaniac that incorporated the most clear blue pieces into their design, because those are the coolest ones.

When asked whether the astronauts, when faced with a construction problem, could use their teeth to separate parts of the space station, Goldin seemed flustered and at a loss for words. Everyone knows that teeth are the only things capable of truly disassembling LEGOs, so this problem will have to be addressed by the design team if the station is going to be a success.

Opponents of the new LEGO station claim that it will be impossible to design a spacesuit with holes in the feet and interchangeable torus.

Goldin concluded by saying, "I can't wait to get up there and play with this one."

New Shuttle experiment involves dukering in space

In a move that will reduce the cost of the space station, NASA announced on Friday that it had conducted experiments on the introduction of duker material into low earth orbit.

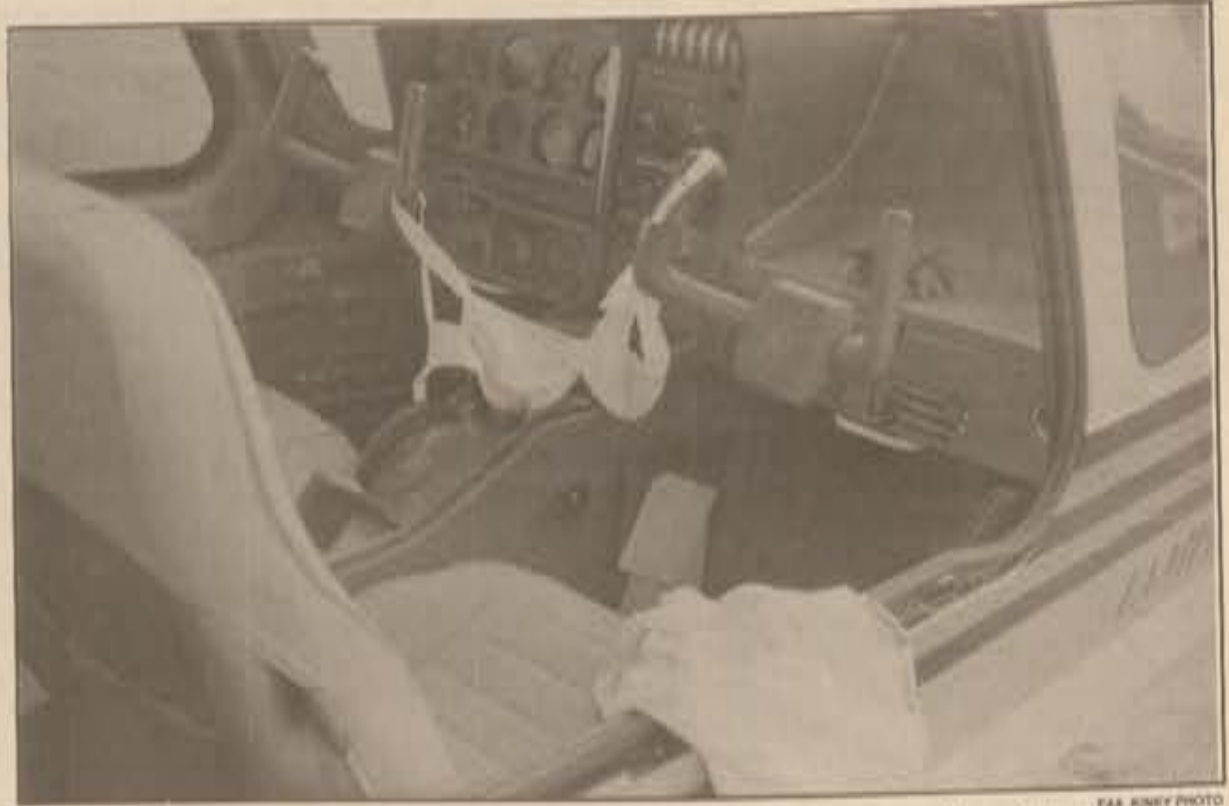

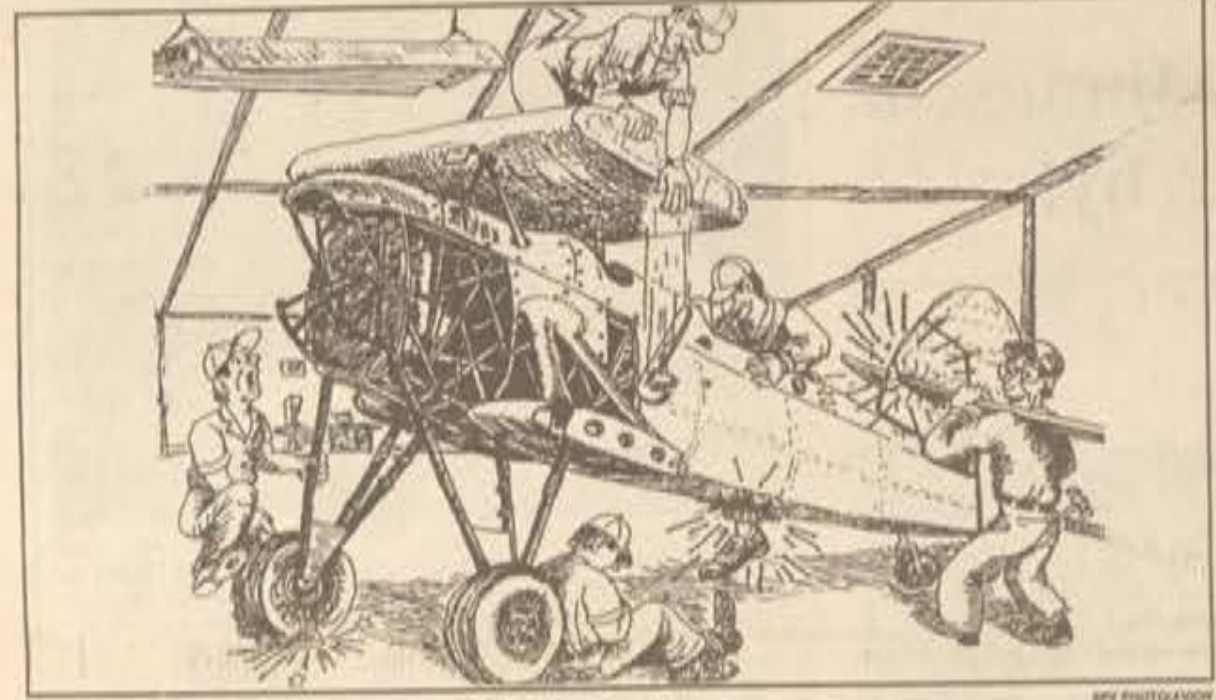

ERAU to start shuttle flight course with NASA

Police were baffled until late last night when a composite sketch from an "I" witness was received. Police currently have two suspects who they are questioning.

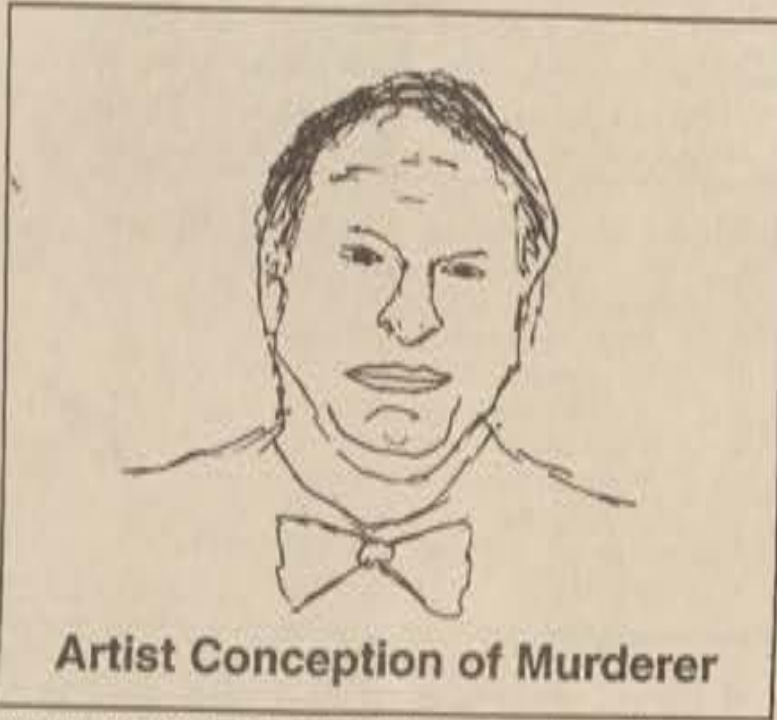
