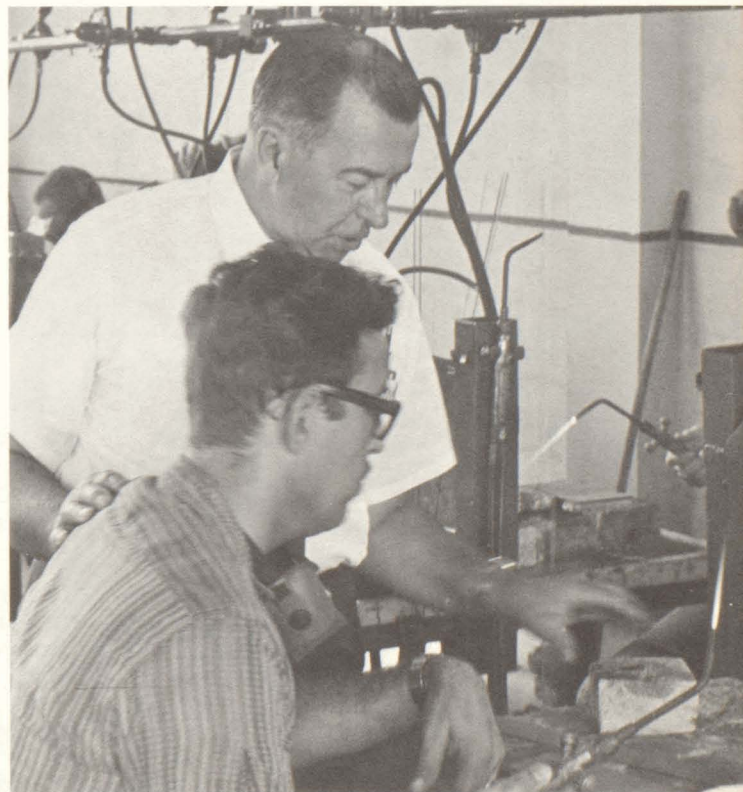
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DEDICATION

We the student body dedicate the 1967 PHOENIX to a much respected, well liked, and very fine gentleman: Mr. Karl E. Lehmann.

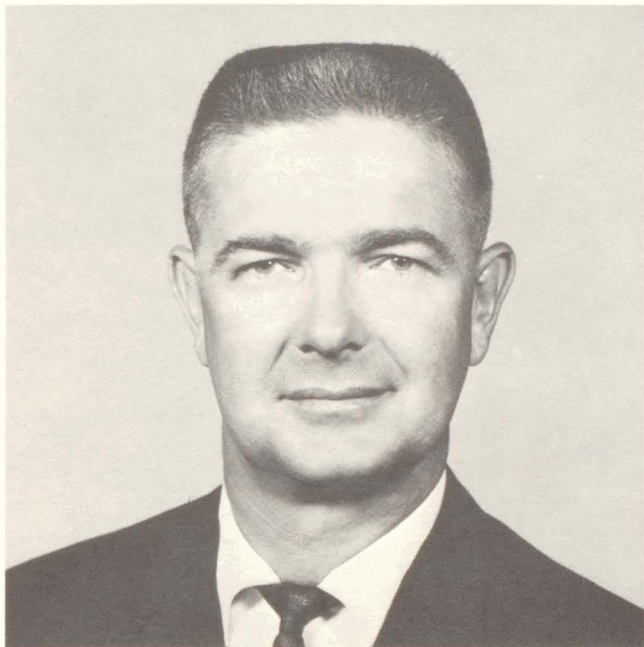




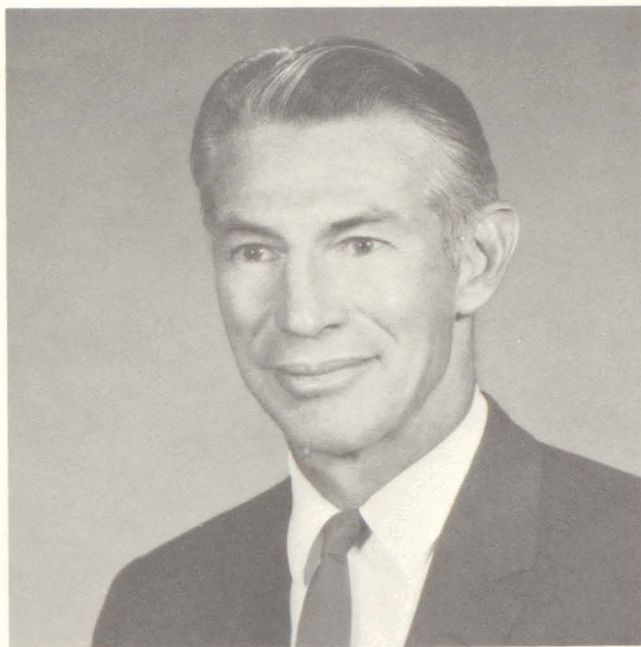

ONWARD AND UPWARD TO . . .

THE FINAL EXAM

Along the road that runs from Matriculation to Graduation, every student must pass through a Final Exam. I'd also like to thank Garrel Noel, Ted Armstrong, Paul Richard, and Good Ole Jim Saunders for their contributions in photography.

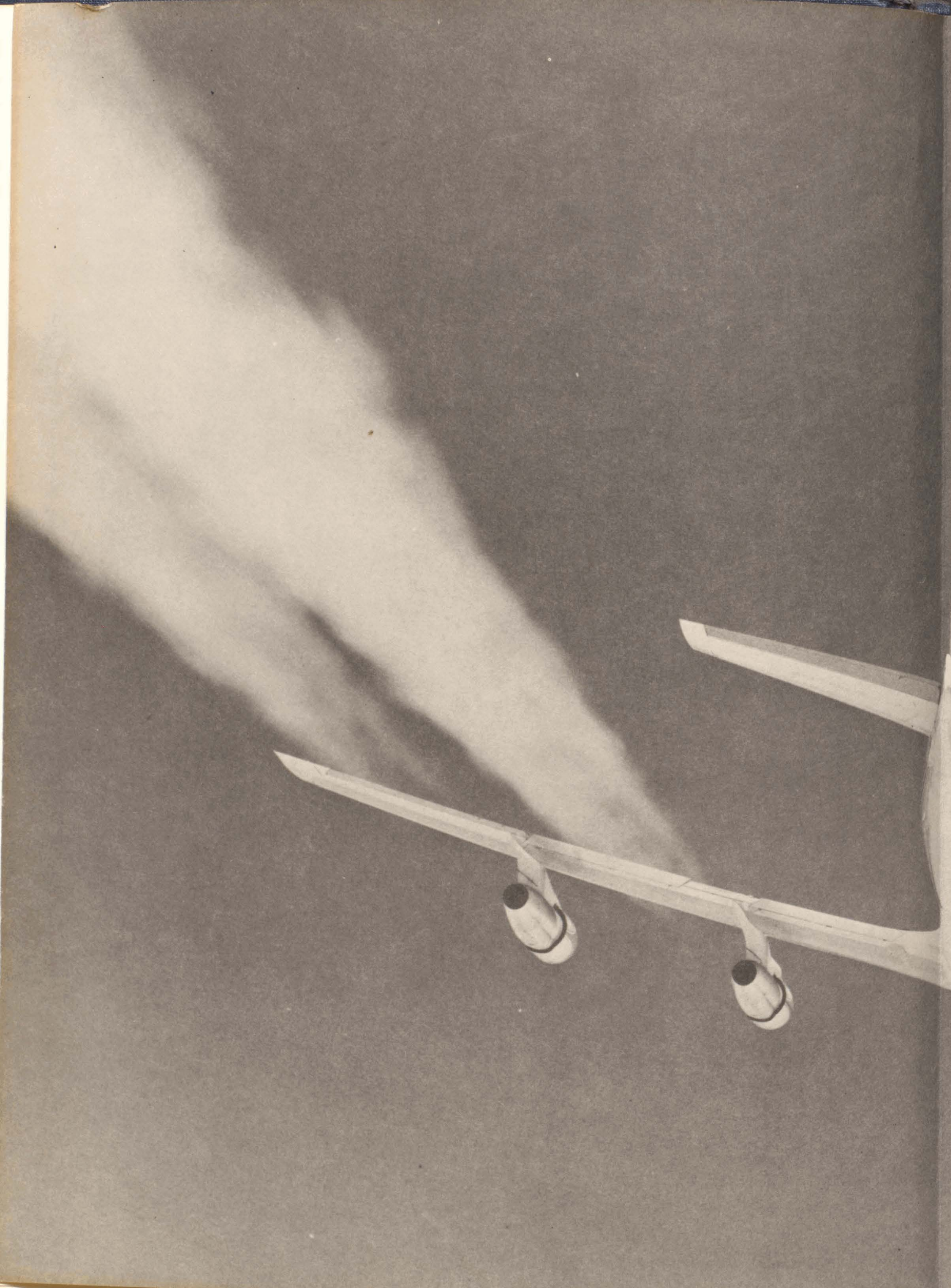
To remain within the law, I also thank E C Publications for letting us use their satire on final exams on pg 50.
